The poems within are a mixture of free verse and more traditional rhymed, formulaic poems, such as sonnets and roundels and discuss a broad variety of topics. The collection is divided into two major sections based on Genesis chapter 1, verse 1: In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. The first major section, then, is heaven, which offers poetry that discusses topics that we might consider to be sacred: heaven, hell, creation, judgement, life, death, prayer, sexuality and sin. The second section is earth, which includes poetry that discusses topics of a more secular nature: art, science, history, mythology, life, death and human nature. While I consider my poetry to be of a more light-hearted nature compared with many other popular writers these days, I am not opposed to using darkness as a tool when a topic requires it. As a result, there are some poems that do delve into darker ideas, such as date rape and even murder, in one case. You will even find one or two naughty...
